

Canine Wellness Recommendations

1 Annual Physical Examination

2 Annual Vaccinations against:

- Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus (DHPP): after the 1st series of this vaccination the next one given is good for 3 years.
- Rabies: Required by law; the first vaccine is for 1yr. after that it is a 3 yr. vaccine.
- Lyme Disease: yearly vaccine
- Leptospirosis: yearly vaccine
- Bordetella:(Kennel Cough), given in a series for puppies then as needed based on exposure at kennels (required to board here), groomers, and other high-traffic dog areas.
- Annual testing for:
 - Heartworms
 - Intestinal Parasites, (fecal sample)
 - Lyme disease and other tick born diseases (as needed based on your pet's exposure to ticks and their vaccination history)
- Year-round monthly preventative medication for:
 - Heartworms
 - Fleas/ticks
- Annual Dental Prophylaxis (if needed)
- Annual/Bi-annual blood-work depending on the medical history and age of your pet
- Puppy Vaccinations and Procedures: These recommendations may vary based on any previous vaccines given and the age of your puppy on the first visit. All puppies and dogs previously unvaccinated need at least 2 vaccines at a 3 week interval with the final vaccine over 15 weeks of age.

DHPP = Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus

Lepto = Leptospirosis

BORD- IN = Bordetella intranasal (first in series)

BORD Inj. = Bordetella injectable (second in series)

HG = Heartgard (heartworm prevention)

REV = Revolution (combination heartworm and flea prevention)

V/C = Vectra and Certifect (flea and tick prevention)

Feline Wellness Recommendations

1 Annual Physical & Dental Examination

2 Annual Vaccination against:

- Rabies: Required by law; the first vaccine is for 1yr. after that it is a 3 yr. vaccine.
- Feline Leukemia: after series, the first vaccine is for 1 year then subsequent vaccines last for 3 years.
- Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, and Panleukopenia (FVRCP): after series the vaccine is then good for 3yrs.

3 Intestinal Parasites, (fecal sample)

• Year-round monthly preventative medication for:

- Heartworms
- Fleas/ticks

1 Annual Dental Prophylaxis (if needed)

2 Feline Leukemia (FeLV/FIV) testing:

- Kittens
- Stray cats
- Older and ill cats
- Shelter and high risk cats
- Cats living with Feline Leukemia or AIDS positive cats
- Previously untested cats

3 Annual/Bi-annual blood-work depending on your cat's history and age

4 Kitten Vaccinations and Procedures: These recommendations may vary based on any previous vaccines given and the age of your kitten on the first visit.

F = Frontline Plus (flea/tick prevention) – only if extra tick prevention is needed.
